

LMC offers Vietnam War series in conjunction with *Lest We Forget*

Lake Michigan College is following up on its successful World War II and Korean War programs with another weekly Community Education series focusing on the Vietnam War. The classes are presented in partnership with the *Lest We Forget* organization and will begin in September.

Vietnam War veterans will facilitate the series, providing a unique and personal perspective. Their presentations will include personal video footage, photographs, maps, war memorabilia and more.

Topics to be covered include:

-How the U.S. became involved in the war

-The influence various presidents had on events

-Key operations and major battles that the U.S. armed forces conducted

-Vietnam history and culture before the war and a look at the country today

-The impact of the media, nightly television coverage, the draft and anti-war protests

The lead instructor for the class is Henry (Hank) B. Richmond III of St. Joseph, a retired Army officer whose service included 10

years of overseas duty in Germany during the Cold War, as well as one combat tour in Vietnam. Richmond also worked for the Pentagon for more than 20 years.

Series begins Sept. 1

The Tuesday series will be held at LMC's Napier Avenue campus in the Blue Lecture Hall (Room D-105) beginning September 1 from 7 to 9 p.m.
